## **Tour Itinerary**

#### Monday 24th November 2025

We depart Staffordshire and start our journey to the North East with comfort stops en route. We stop at the historic city of Durham for lunch (at own expense). In the afternoon, we continue travelling north in to Northumberland and to the White Swan Hotel in Alnwick. (D)

#### **Tuesday 25th November 2025**

Today we travel north to Bamburgh to visit the fascinating Bamburgh Castle. The castle comes alive at Christmas time with beautiful decorations and festivities. We drive back to the hotel to enjoy the afternoon at leisure in Alnwick. (B,D)

#### Wednesday 26th November 2025

After breakfast, we journey to Lindisfarne, also known as Holy Island. Saint Cuthbert, a 7thcentury monk and bishop, lived and served on Lindisfarne, and pilgrims still visit today. We enjoy a scenic drive around the island and take a refreshment stop. In the afternoon, we journey to Berwick-Upon-Tweed, one of the most northernly towns in England. Here you can enjoy time at leisure to get some lunch (at own expense), maybe do some Christmas shopping or perhaps explore the castle ruins before we drive back to the hotel. (B,D)

#### **Thursday 27th November 2025**

This morning, we meet our Blue Badge tour guide and enjoy a scenic drive around Northumberland. On our journey we will make stops in the small villages of Amble and Alnmouth, where our guide will share their knowledge on the history and stories of these picturesque locations. Our afternoon takes us to NT Wallington to explore the exquisite house and gardens with our Blue Badge Guide. At Christmas, National Trust Wallington transforms into a festive wonderland with sparkling lights, decorated trees, and seasonal displays. (B,D)

### Friday 28th November 2025

We depart the hotel and travel to York to enjoy some lunch (at own expense). You may wish to explore some of the Christmas markets or do some Christmas shopping. We continue our journey back home to Staffordshire arriving early evening. (B)
