Sunday 14th December 2025

Today you have a day at leisure to explore wonderful Wells. Perhaps visit the beautiful Bishop's Palace and gardens (at own expense). A must see is the breathtaking Wells Cathedral and the adjourning Vicars' Close, believed to be the only complete medieval street left in England. This significant landmark was designed to provide communal accommodation for the Vicars Choral, who sang daily. This centuries old tradition still continues today and is a unique and much valued part of life at Wells Cathedral. We depart Wells early afternoon and travel back to Staffordshire. (B)
