This vibrant Norwegian city oozes charm and was awarded the title of European Capital of Culture in 2008. The old town, Gamle Stavanger, has narrow winding streets and ancient wooden houses, gathered around a historic fresh fish and vegetable market.

#### Saturday 24th January 2026 - Cruising Åkrafjord & Langfoss Waterfall

Enjoy an incredible scenic cruise along the Åkrafjord past the mighty Langfoss Waterfall, where it's almost possible to feel the spray of this magnificent natural wonder. Widely regarded as one of Norway's best waterfalls.

#### Sunday 25th January 2026 - Olden, Norway

Located at the eastern end of the Nordfjord where it divides into three arms beneath the glaciers of the Jostedalsgreen, the charming village of Olden sits among green meadows, towering cliff faces, and sparkling glacial waters. In the centre of the village is the Old Church. Later this afternoon, we will be cruising Nordfjord and Innvikfjord. The sixth longest Norwegian fjord and one of the most picturesque, Nordfjord stretches from mainland Norway's westernmost point to the magnificent Jostedalsgreen.

#### Monday 26th January 2026 - Haugesund, Norway

The birth place of Norway, Haugesund dates back to the Viking Age, where it's said that the first Viking King of Norway, Harald Hargagre is buried. The town has developed into a thriving commercial area, while still retaining its small-town charm.

### Tuesday 27th January 2026 - Lerwick, Scotland

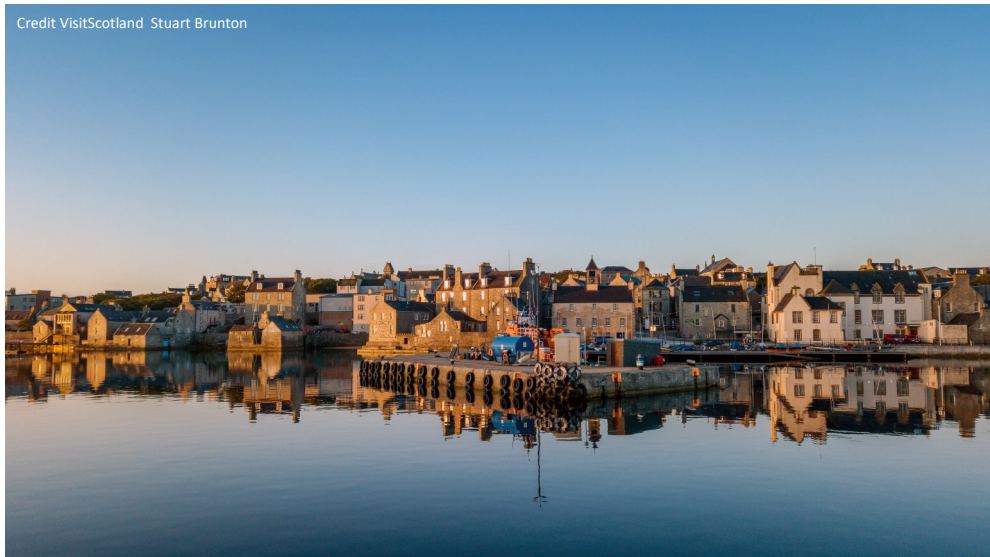
Capital of the Shetland Islands, Lerwick is a popular tourist destination, thanks to its stunning coastlines. Close by are the soaring cliffs of Sumburgh Head, which are perfect for spotting various examples of marine life. Here we will have a chance to join the festivities of the annual Up Helly Aa Festival. This traditional fire festival has roots in ancient Norse traditions and celebrates Shetland's Viking heritage. Organised by local communities, it is led by a squad of Viking warriors known as the Jarl Squad, with the leader, known as the Guizer Jarl, representing a different character from Norse mythology or history. One of Europe's largest fire festivals, it involves various events and culminates in the burning of a replica Viking longship.

### Wednesday 28th - Thursday 29th January 2026 - At sea.

A couple days at sea, perhaps treat yourself to afternoon tea or a spa treatment.

### Friday 30th January 2026

Arrive back into Southampton this morning with wonderful memories of our holiday.
