Thursday 4th June 2026

Meet your Regent Tour Manager and fellow travellers at the port of Southampton. We embark the beautiful Borealis, our home for the next 14 nights.

Friday 5th - Saturday 6th June 2026 - At sea

A wonderful three days to relax and explore the fabulous facilities on Borealis, our floating hotel.

Sunday 7th June 2026 - Copenhagen, Denmark

We arrive in Copenhagen today, one of the oldest cities in Europe. Its monarchy dates back as far as the 8th century, and is home to the impressive Royal Family's Amalienborg Palace and Christianborg Palace. The Danish crown jewels are housed at Rosenborg Castle, surrounded by beautiful gardens. The Little Mermaid Statue, based on Hans Christian Andersen's 1836 story, sits on the shoreline looking for her prince; while the Nyhavn District reveals canals lined with historic wooden ships and brightly coloured townhouses.

Monday 8th June 2026 - At sea

A day at sea, perhaps treat yourself to a treatment in the spa.

Tuesday 9th June 2026 - Gdańsk, Poland

Today we are in Gdańsk, one of the largest ports in the Baltic with over 1000 years of seafaring traditions. Gdańsk, is considered Poland's maritime capital and is one of the country's most important and dynamic cities. The city features an abundance of attractions, discovered in and around scenes of historic streets, riverside walkways and impressive boulevards. The 'main town' is at the top of the list of the must-visit areas to discover with its streets and squares displaying fine examples of various architectural styles.

Wednesday 10th June 2026 - Klaipeda, Lithuania

Lithuania's only port city, Klaipeda has maritime connections at its heart, with an abundance of museums dedicated to seafaring tales, as well as hosting a biennial tall ships regatta. The city changed significantly after the Second World War, but still has a collection of monuments and half-timbered houses from before this time, which contrast with the Curonian Spit National Park, established in 1991 to protect its unique ecosystems.

Thursday 11th June 2026 - Riga, Latvia

Home to over 800 Art Nouveau buildings, Riga is located at the mouth of the River Daugava, and boasts a unique blend of centuries-old churches, castles and traditional wooden buildings with modern structures. In the pedestrianised Old Town, now a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is the bustling Livu Square, complemented by quaint restaurants and bars, selling the intriguingly named Latvian drink, Black Balsam.

Friday 12th June - Saturday 13th June 2026 - Tallinn, Estonia

Tallinn, Estonia's capital, is unquestionably one of Europe's most magical capitals. This ancient Hanseatic city is justifiably proud of its beautiful churches, solid limestone houses and well-preserved cobbled streets. Toompea Hill, with its medieval houses and alleyways, is the oldest part, and at its foot, substantial remains of the city wall can still be seen, surrounded by well-maintained parks. The medieval town hall is one of the best preserved in northern Europe, and the weatherclock, Gamble Toomas, is an enduring symbol of Tallinn. Other notable architecture includes the ornate, 19th century St. Alexander Nevskij Cathedral and The Kadriorg's Castle, built by Peter the Great.

Sunday 14th June 2026 - At sea

A day to relax at sea.

Monday 15th June 2026 - Warnemünde, Germany

Today we arrive in Warnemünde, a former fishing village located along the Baltic Sea. With a wide promenade that runs parallel to the sea, it leads to the well-known lighthouse where a laser and light show is celebrated on each New Year's Day. The Alter Strom canal is full of colourful boats and surrounded with lively restaurants, and close by is Alexandrinenstraße, a quaint street lined with small houses and tall trees.

Tuesday 16th - Wednesday 17th June 2026 - At sea.

A couple days at sea, perhaps treat yourself to afternoon tea or a spa treatment.

Thursday 18th June 2026

We arrive back into Southampton this morning.
