Saturday 24th January 2026

Sunday 25th January 2026

This morning we travel to the Robert Burns Birthplace Museum where you have time to explore. The Burns Birthplace Museum in Alloway, celebrates the life and legacy of poet Robert Burns, featuring his childhood home, artifacts, and interactive exhibits. In the afternoon, we meet a blue badge guide for a short guided tour of Ayrshire to learn all about the fascinating history of Robert Burns and see the places that inspired his poetry. We travel back to the hotel mid afternoon to freshen up before our Burns supper where quilts and Scottish attire is optional. Tonight we enjoy an authentic Scottish Piper with Burns speaker along with a set 4 course themed Burns supper. (B,D)

Monday 26th January 2026

After a leisurely breakfast, we head to Glasgow to meet our Blue Badge Guide to enjoy a guided tour of the city on board the coach. See the major sights and historical locations around the city including the beautiful Glasgow cathedral. We finish the tour at the Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum. Here you have time to explore the extensive collections of art paintings, sculptures and artifacts. In the afternoon, enjoy time at leisure to explore the rest of the city. (B,D)

Tuesday 27th January 2026

We depart our hotel this morning and start our journey home. We make a stop en route for you to get some lunch (at own expense) before we continue our drive back to Staffordshire. (B)
