Wednesday 3rd June 2026

Visit St. Martin's today, the third largest island of the Scilly's, which is famous for having the clearest seas in the British Isles. The tranquil waters and sandy beaches are simply stunning. Free time at leisure before returning to St. Mary's mid-afternoon. This evening dine at one of the many restaurants on St Mary's (at own expense). (B)

Thursday 4th June 2026

Hop to the neighbouring islands of Tresco and Bryher today, with free time to explore each. Tresco is surrounded by long stretches of sandy beaches and is famous for its Abbey Gardens, a sub-tropical wonderland filled with unusual plant species. Bryher is the smallest inhabited island of the Isles of Scilly, with a wild and dramatic landscape ideal for walking. Enjoy free time before returning to our St. Mary's hotel. (B,D)

Friday 5th June 2026

Today is a full free day to spend as you wish. St. Mary's is the largest and most populated island in the Isles of Scilly, a beautiful place with many walking trails and activities. Perhaps explore historic Hugh Town, venture to Porthellick Cove, or take a circular boat trip from St. Mary's harbour. Some of the boat trips visit Bishops Rock Lighthouse, where you can go seabird watching and more. (B,D)

Saturday 6th June 2026

This beautiful island has plenty to offer, from the delightful Troytown Ice Cream Farm, a great treat on a sunny day, to the Turk's Head pub previously voted the most scenic pub in the UK! It is also a shell collector's paradise, with great variety of molluscs and unusual sea-life washed up here. Return to our hotel for dinner this evening. (B,D)

Sunday 7th June 2026

Another free day to enjoy the delights of these breath-taking isles. Head off on a wildlife cruise or perhaps explore one of the more remote uninhabited islands. Or why not stay local and visit one of St. Mary's gorgeous beaches, and relax for the day. (B,D)

Monday 8th June 2026

We have a leisurely morning before we say goodbye to St. Mary's this afternoon, as we take the ferry back to Penzance. Upon arrival in Cornwall our coach will collect us and take us to our overnight hotel, we arrive in the evening and supper will be available at own expense. (B)

Tuesday 9th June 2026

After an early breakfast, we begin our journey north, with comfort stops en-route. We arrive back in Staffordshire early evening. (B)

Facilities: Enjoy an indoor swimming pool. Restaurant serves local produce. Wi-Fi available. Please note that this hotel is over 100 years old and has a steep Georgian staircase and no lift, with some rooms on upper floors. Ground floor rooms available on request. Portage included.

Please Note: Seaside towns in Cornwall will not take overnight groups in peak season and our overnights in Cornwall are at the Wetherspoon Hotel in Camborne, wonderfully located for our onward travel. This is fine for overnights, but Camborne is not a resort or holiday town.

Some island terrain may be rugged and uneven. We will be using island ferry boats to reach other islands.
