Tour Itinerary

Tuesday 24th February 2026

We take a flight from Liverpool airport to Larnaca in Cyprus. Upon arrival, transfer to Bellapais Gardens in Kyrenia, our home for the next 7 nights. We arrive at our hotel late evening, where we will enjoy welcome cocktails and a light snack. (D)

Wednesday 25th February 2026

After breakfast we meet in the reception area and transfer to the starting point of our first walk. Our walk today takes us from Five Finger Mountain down to Alagadi Turtle Beach, with panoramic views of the unspoiled natural beauty of the north of Cyprus. Alagadi beach is one of the major and most beautiful beaches in this region, with an amazing backdrop of the Five Finger Mountains. Enjoy a late lunch at a lovely beach taverna (at own expense) before returning to our hotel. (B,D)

Thursday 26th February 2026

We travel into the mountains to the village of Kantara today. From here we take an undulating path along the coastline, with breathtaking views of the Crusader Castle, which dates back to the 10th century and has many references of visits by Richard the Lion Heart. We return to the pretty village of Kaplica for lunch at a local taverna (at own expense). (B,D)

Friday 27th February 2026

Today we take the well defined trail from Alevkaya to Antiphonitis Church. Walking through the lush green pine forest take in magnificent coastal views to the north and south of the island. Our trail arrives at the Antiphonitis Monastery, which is said to be one of the most delightful monuments on the whole island. We continue our walk and gently descend to the charming old village of Esentepe, perhaps indulge in a meze style lunch here (at own expense). During this walk discover stunning scenery and wonderful views across the plains and watch the glorious Mediterranean sea glisten throughout the day. (B,D)

Itinerary Continued...

Saturday 28th February 2026

Enjoy time at leisure to explore the resort of Kyrenia this morning, which boasts a stunning harbour dominated by a Venetian castle and a promenade full of shops, bars and tavernas. Alternatively, you can join our optional excursion to the Karpaz Peninsula, which has numerous Byzantine Churches and some of the finest countryside. Adorned with myriad birds, wild flowers and sea fossils, it is known as 'the nature reserve of Cyprus'. **(Optional excursion cost £50pp and must be booked at the time of booking.)** (B,D)

Sunday 1st March 2026

After breakfast we travel to the Old Walled City of Famagusta. Steeped in history with remarkable ruins, marvel at the impressive fortifications and fascinating medieval architecture on our guided tour, with free time to explore. Perhaps have a wander to its pretty harbour, partake in some retail therapy or relax over lunch (at own expense). (B,D)

Monday 2nd March 2026

Our last day takes us via the high forest trail, heading from Alevkayasi to Sourp Magar Monastery. Standing at 530 metres above sea level and also referred to as the Monastery of the Virgin Mary, Sourp Magar has been a religious centre for the Armenians for centuries. Enjoy a picnic lunch in the monastery garden (at own expense) before returning back to our hotel. (B,D)

Tuesday 3rd March 2026

We say goodbye to Cyprus today, but with time for a relaxing day before taking a mid evening flight back to Liverpool and arriving back early Wednesday morning. (B)

Regent Walking & Mobility

Guided walks on this tour consist of 3 to 5 hours of easy to moderate walking over varied and undulating terrain. Although some pathways are easily navigable, some trails may be more strenuous, we make regular rest stops, to enjoy the scenery.

Walking distances range between 3 miles and 7 miles per day. This tour is suitable for people with a good level of fitness and stamina.

All walks will be escorted by a Regent Tour Manager and an expert local guide. Our local guide will give information on all points of interest during the walking programme.
