Tour Itinerary

Friday 7th August 2026

We depart Staffordshire and make our way north to Levens Hall near Kendal. Levens Hall is a privately-owned house and gardens, home to the world's oldest topiary gardens and centre of a thriving 9,500 acre agricultural estate. Mid afternoon, we continue to our home for the next 3 nights, the Redworth Hall Hotel. (D)

Saturday 8th August 2026

After breakfast, we head to the Bowes Museum, a magnificent French-styled building. Here you will have time to wander the Museum's permanent collections and the thousands of objects from silver and metals, fashion and textiles to capturing your imagination with the sculptures and paintings. Enjoy early dinner at our hotel before travelling to Bishop Auckland and the majestic castle, for an evening of 'Mystical Tales of England' the Kynren. This spectacular open-air live show relays over 2000 years of British history over the course of the evening. A spell-binding event, this will be a truly unique and memorable time. (B,D)

Sunday 9th August 2026

Today, we step back in time with a visit to the Beamish Museum, a world famous open air museum which brings the history of North East England to life at its 1820s Pockerley, 1900s Town, 1900s Pit Village, 1940s Farm and 1950s Town, or take a ride aboard the tramway around it's 1½ mile circular track. We arrive back at the hotel mid-afternoon. (B,D)

Monday 10th August 2026

We depart the hotel after breakfast and make our way to Raby Castle. Raby is one of the most impressive intact castles in the North of England. Built in the 14th century by the powerful Neville family, it has a long history. The approach to the castle is particularly beautiful as it towers appear and disappear amongst the trees of the surrounding parkland with its ornamental lakes and herds of deer. We depart mid afternoon and drive back to Staffordshire. (B)
