Tour Itinerary

Sunday 8th February 2026

We begin with a scenic drive through Shropshire to the medieval market town of Ludlow, with time to stroll its compact historic heart and perhaps enjoy an early lunch. Continuing into Herefordshire, here we discover our first specialist snowdrop garden, the delightful Ivy Croft Gardens and Nursery. Spread across a four-acre haven of meadows, woodland and orchards, where drifts of snowdrops weave through the landscape. Part of the National Garden Scheme, owner Roger Norman has created a true oasis for snowdrop enthusiasts, with a wonderful range to purchase. We then head to our welcoming hotel with time to settle before dinner. (D)

Monday 9th February 2026

Today offers a true treat for snowdrop lovers. Our morning visit takes us to the romantic and secluded Cerney House Gardens in the Cotswolds, described by Country Living as "what most people aspire to in their gardens – but few achieve." Its winding woodland walks are beautifully carpeted with over 100 varieties of snowdrops, creating a magical atmosphere. In the afternoon we step into one of Britain's most celebrated snowdrop displays, the Rococo Gardens at Painswick. Designed in the 1740s as a whimsical pleasure garden, its hidden valley transformed into an unforgettable sea of white. After a day steeped in beauty and history, we return to our hotel for a delicious dinner. (B,D)

Tuesday 10th February 2026

After breakfast, we visit Old Court Nurseries & Picton Gardens, a hidden gem with over 300 varieties of snowdrops framed by the Malvern Hills. On our return, we pause in the delightful town of Ledbury, with its half-timbered buildings and cobbled lanes, before journeying back to Staffordshire. (B)
