Tour Itinerary

Monday 13th July 2026

We depart Staffordshire and journey north arriving at Levens Hall. Located at the gateway to the Lake District National Park, this beautiful privately-owned family house and garden, has grown from the imposing Pele Tower built c1250-1300, and is home to the world's oldest topiary gardens and centre of a thriving 9,500-acre agricultural estate which provides much of the produce for the cafe, Levens Kitchen. After lunch (at own expense) we continue to our hotel, our home for the next 4 nights. (D)

Tuesday 14th July 2026

This morning, we make our way to Haverthwaite Station for a nostalgic steam train journey to Lakeside station. Here we join our Lake Windemere cruise taking us around the South of the lake finishing in the Victorian town of Bowness-on-Windemere. Here you have time to explore and get lunch (at own expense) before we take a visit to Blackwell Arts and Crafts Centre. We return to the hotel with time to freshen up before dinner. (B,D)

Wednesday 15th July 2026

We depart the hotel and make our way to Dalemmain House and Gardens for a guided tour of the mansion. We'll learn about the history of the Grade I listed country house and the Dalemmain World Marmalade Awards. Explore the award winning RHS Plantsman's Garden at leisure, maybe visit the shop before enjoying an included cream tea. Never far from the water, we return to our hotel via Pooley Bridge for a cruise on the Ullswater Steamer to Glenridding, arriving back in time for dinner. (B,D)

Thursday 16th July 2026

Today, we sit back for a tour of the picturesque Lake District, travelling from Windemere to Ambleside, past the pretty Bridge House and on to Grasmere. The scenery of Grasmere inspiring Wordsworth's poem 'I wandered Lonely as a Cloud'. Finally we make our way to Keswick nestled between Skiddaw and the serenity of Derwentwater with time to explore this market town, full of shops, restaurants and museums. We then return to our hotel for dinner. (B,D)

Friday 17th July 2026

Time this morning to explore the town of Kendal, just a short walk from your hotel, find somewhere for lunch (at own expense) before we make our way back to Staffordshire early afternoon. (B)
