Tour Itinerary

Monday 6th July 2026

Departing Staffordshire this morning, we journey south to Waterperry Gardens. Take time to explore the beautiful gardens and enjoy lunch (at own expense) in the café before heading to the 4* Hydro Hotel on the outskirts of Eastbourne, our hotel for the next 4 nights. (D)

Tuesday 7th July 2026

After a leisurely breakfast, we travel to Herstmonceux Castle Estate and Gardens. Enjoy the morning exploring the magnificent 15th-century red-brick castle, stroll through the themed and formal gardens, wander the woodland trails and lakeside grounds, and discover the rich history and natural beauty of the estate. In the afternoon, we drive back to Eastbourne to enjoy free time in the centre. (B,D)

Wednesday 8th July 2026

This morning we travel to the quaint Pashley Manor Gardens. Here you can see its beautiful roses, lush herbaceous borders, and vibrant summer blooms, all set against the backdrop of tranquil ponds and sweeping countryside views. In the afternoon we travel to Great Dixter House and Gardens where you can explore the historic timber-framed house, wander through a series of richly planted garden rooms and admire the famous topiary and wildflower meadows. We return to the hotel in time for dinner. (B,D)

Thursday 9th July 2026

This morning we travel to Brighton where we include a guided tour of the Royal Pavilion. This spectacular seaside palace of the Prince Regent (George IV) was transformed by John Nash between 1815 and 1823, into one of the most distinctive and unusual buildings in England. Enjoy time at leisure to take lunch (at own expense) and explore the sights of Brighton. We transfer back to the hotel. (B,D)

Friday 10th July 2026

We say goodbye to the south coast today and travel to the market town of Aylesbury for time at leisure to get lunch (at own expense) and explore. We travel back to Staffordshire arriving early evening. (B)
