Tour Itinerary

Monday 8th June 2026

We depart Staffordshire and start our journey to Devon. We make a stop in Cheddar with time to get lunch (at own expense) and explore, before continuing our journey to our hotel in Tiverton. (D)

Tuesday 9th June 2026

This morning, we enjoy free time in Tiverton where you can enjoy some shopping in the pretty shops or perhaps choose to visit Tiverton Castle (at own expense), where you can see a fine collection of English Civil War arms and armour. In the afternoon, we board our horse draw barge for a gentle cruise along the Great Western Canal, enjoying the scenic views that this peaceful mode of transport has to offer. We return to our hotel, where we enjoy a lovely cream tea. (B,D)

Wednesday 10th June 2026

After a leisurely breakfast, we travel to Bishops Lydeard to join the West Somerset Railway. Being the longest steam railway in Britain, this single journey will showcase beautiful scenery travelling through the Quantock Hills and finishing in Minehead. This afternoon we enjoy a scenic drive along the coast to the seaside village of Lynmouth, before we return to the hotel. (B,D)

Thursday 11th June 2026

Today, we enjoy a visit to the market town of Barnstaple for time at leisure. Alternatively, you may wish to join our optional excursion to RHS Gardens Rosemoor (additional charge, must be booked at time of booking). Later, we travel to Quince Honey Farm. We include a guided tour of the honey factory where you will learn about all things honey! (B,D)

Friday 12th June 2026

We depart our hotel this morning and start our journey home. We stop en route at Yeo Valley with time to explore their organic garden and to get lunch (at own expense). We continue our drive back to Staffordshire. (B,D)
