Thursday 2nd September 2027

We embark the beautiful ship Balmoral at Southampton, our home for the next 10 nights.

Friday 3rd September 2027- At sea

A wonderful day at sea to relax and explore the fabulous facilities on Balmoral, our floating hotel.

Saturday 4th September 2027- Cruising the Kiel Canal

Today we continue our cruising journey along the famous Kiel Canal. From the decks of your ship, you can watch the fascinating operation of the Brunsbüttel lock system, as water levels are carefully adjusted to allow safe passage. We also pass through Holtenau Lock. Opened in 1895 and expanded over the years, the Holtenau Lock is a key gateway between the Baltic and North Sea, and your unique advantage point on-board the ship, you can watch the lock in action as water levels rise or fall, and the vast gates slowly open.

Sunday 5th September 2027 - Trelleborg, Sweden

The southernmost town in Sweden, Trelleborg is known as 'the city of palm trees', an unusual sight for Scandinavia. The town provides an important link between Sweden and the rest of Europe, with its busy port area. The town is most famous for its rich Viking history, having been named after a circular fort built by the Vikings. At the Trelleborg Viking Fortress, step back in time to the Viking Age and explore one of the best-preserved circular fortresses in the world. The site features reconstructed Viking houses, a recreated longhouse, and the remains of the original fortress earthworks.

Monday 6th September 2027 - Gdansk, Poland

Gdansk is considered Poland's maritime capital and is one of the country's most important and dynamic cities. The city features an abundance of attractions discovered in and around scenes of historic streets, riverside walkways and impressive boulevards begging to showcase their highlights. The 'main town' is at the top of the list of the must-visit areas to discover. Here you'll find streets and squares displaying fine examples of various architectural styles, as well as many museums and monuments.

Tuesday 7th September 2027 - Ventspils, Latvia

Set on Latvia's scenic west coast, Ventspils combines golden Baltic beaches with a proud Hanseatic history. As you stroll its cobbled streets dotted with colourful cow sculptures designed by local and international artists, you will also be able to enjoy the many flowers and fountains Ventspils is renowned for, before exploring the striking 17th-century castle that stands at the heart of the old town.

Wednesday 8th September 2027 - Klaipeda, Lithuania

Lithuania's only port city, Klaipeda, has maritime connections at its heart, with an abundance of museums dedicated to seafaring tales, as well as hosting a biennial tall ships regatta. The city changed significantly after the Second World War, but still has a collection of monuments and half-timbered houses from before this time. Museums, such as the Lithuanian Sea Museum and Klaipeda Castle Museum, provide insights into the region's maritime and cultural heritage.

Thursday 9th September 2027 - Copenhagen, Denmark

Copenhagen is one of the oldest cities in Europe, with its monarchy dating back as far as the 8th century, and home to the impressive Royal Family's Amalienborg Palace and Christianborg Palace. You can take a visit to see the Danish crown jewels on display at Rosenborg Castle which is surrounded by beautiful gardens. A must see when visiting Copenhagen is the Little Mermaid Statue, based on Hans Christian Andersen's 1836 story; she sits on the shoreline looking for her prince.

Friday 10th September 2027 - Cruising the Kiel Canal

A day to relax and enjoy the scenery as we sail back along the Kiel Canal. Your scenic journey passes through quiet countryside and canal-edge villages, offering a unique opportunity to experience Germany's landscapes from the comfort of your ship, and witness one of Europe's great maritime routes at work.

Saturday 11th September 2027 - At sea

A day at sea, perhaps treat yourself to afternoon tea or a spa treatment or just have time to yourself.

Sunday 12th September 2027

Arrive back into Southampton this morning, for your onward journey home..
