#### Friday 26th March 2027 - Cruising Oslofjord

The Olsen family home in Hvitsten is located on the shores of Oslofjord, with the impressive Lysedal Mansion overlooking the waters. The inner part of the fjord is lined with dense forests, and is well known for the small group of islands that lie close to Oslo, whose beaches are hugely popular with locals. We arrive in Oslo this evening.

#### Saturday 27th March 2027 - Oslo

Norway's capital city, Oslo has been an important maritime destination for centuries, and is home to many maritime-related companies, including ship-owners and brokers. Surrounded by mountains and the impressive Oslofjord, where Fred. Olsen originated in 1848 in the small town of Hvitsten, is located on its shores. The city has many cultural and historical structures; including the impressive Vigeland Sculpture Park, and is also home to the National Gallery.

#### Sunday 28th March 2027 - Cruising Gullmarsfjorden

The Gullmarsfjord, or Gullmarn as its known locally, is western Sweden's largest and most distinctive fjord, thanks to its deep blue, fauna filled waters. Named the country's first marine conservation area in 1983, the fjord is renowned for its unique marine species, including cuttlefish, king crab, dragonet and gurnard and is popular with keen anglers from all over the world.

### Monday 29th March 2027 - Malmö, Sweden

Today we arrive in Malmö, a charming city where historic streets meet modern flair. Wander through Gamla Staden's cobbled lanes and elegant squares. From the harbour, the world's longest cable-tied road and rail bridge, Öresund Bridge, directly links Malmö to Copenhagen. Everywhere you turn, Malmö offers something to delight the senses. We arrive in Copenhagen this evening.

### Tuesday 30th March 2027 - Copenhagen, Denmark

Copenhagen is one of the oldest cities in Europe, with its monarchy dating back as far as the 8th century, and home to the impressive Royal Family's Amalienborg Palace and Christianborg Palace. The Danish crown jewels are housed to Rosenborg Castle, surrounded by beautiful gardens. The diminutive Little Mermaid statue, based on Hans Christian Andersen's 1836 story, sits on the shoreline looking for her prince; while the Nyhavn District reveals canals lined with historic wooden ships and brightly coloured houses.

### Wednesday 31st March 2027 - At Sea

A day to relax at sea and maybe enjoy the on-board facilities of Bolette where there is a choice of arts and crafts, games and sporting activities as well as the gym.

### Thursday 1st April 2027

Arrive back into Newcastle this morning, for your onward journey home.
