Thursday 24th June 2027

We embark the beautiful Bolette at Newcastle, our home for the next 14 nights.

Friday 25th June 2027 - At sea

A day at sea to relax and explore the fabulous facilities on Bolette.

Saturday 26th June 2027 - Molde

Today we arrive in Molde, a picturesque town, known for its love of Jazz. Molde is located alongside the Romsdalsfjord. From here, the Atlantic Ocean Road, linking Molde with Kristiansund stretches for eight kilometres through beautiful rocky coastlines, over the sea and through the surrounding mountains, featuring incredible bridges and architecture.

Sunday 27th June 2027 - Scenic Cruising

We are scenic cruising today. Located on the island of Torget, Torghatten Mountain is one of Norway's most astonishing natural wonders. Torghatten is famous for the huge hole which strikes right through the middle of it. Later this afternoon, we cruise past the Seven Sisters Mountain Range, an awe-inspiring backdrop to a myriad of islands. Standing 1000 feet above the shoreline, these striking peaks are perhaps best observed in all their glory from your cruise ship. We continue our journey north and cross the Arctic Circle. Embarking on the maritime tradition of crossing the Arctic Circle is a cherished experience for guests and crew alike. This momentous occasion, often announced by the Captain, invites you to venture out on deck and celebrate.

Monday 28th June 2027 - Sortland

Known as 'Blue Town', the unique town of Sortland was given its nickname due to its buildings being almost entirely painted in varying shades of blue, chosen by local artist Bjorn Elvenes. The surrounding waters of the town are teeming with various species of fish, seabirds, seals and whales; and rugged, unspoilt landscapes are the town's backdrop.

Tuesday 29th June 2027 - Hammerfest

Today we arrive in Hammerfest, recognised as the world's most northerly urban town, and is also one of Norway's oldest towns. Despite being virtually destroyed during the Second World War, Hammerfest retains many colourful houses from the 1950s. Thanks to its northerly location, the town experiences the phenomenon of the 'midnight sun' during the summer months.

Wednesday 30th June 2027 - At Sea

Enjoy a day at sea, perhaps indulge in afternoon tea or treat yourself to a spa treatment.

Thursday 1st - Friday 2nd July 2027 - Longyearbyen

Located deep within the Arctic Circle, Longyearbyen is seen as the world's most northernmost town, and is surrounded by incredible Norwegian Arctic wilderness. The sun doesn't set here in the summer months, and is the gateway to many Arctic adventure in Svalbard. Home to reindeer, arctic fox, and a range of cetaceans, Longyearbyen is the perfect place for observing wildlife in its natural habitat.

Saturday 3rd July 2027 - At Sea

Enjoy a day at sea, perhaps treat yourself to a spa treatment or see what's going on around the ship in your daily times.

Sunday 4th July 2027 - Tromsø

We arrive in Tromsø today, also known as the 'gateway to the Arctic'. The city is one of Norway's cultural gems and offers something for everyone; whether you would like to immerse yourself in Sami culture or enjoy views from atop Mount Storsteinen. Tromsø is famed for its unique natural environment.

Monday 5th July 2027 - At Sea

Tuesday 6th July 2027 - Kristiansund

Often referred to as the Atlantic City, due to its close proximity to one of the world's most scenic roadways, the Atlantic Road, Kristiansund is home to much of Norway's most iconic modern architecture. The Atlantic Road is a true feat of engineering, offering breath-taking scenery and culture at every point, as it snakes over a series of small islands, spanned by a total of eight bridges.
