



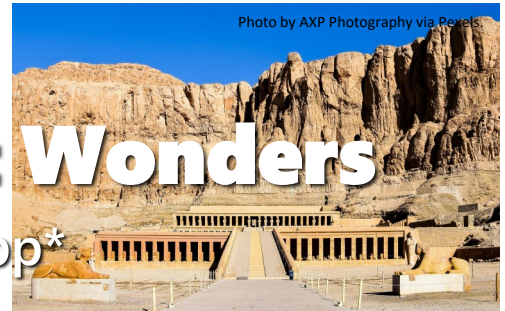

Friday 22nd January 2027

This morning, enjoy a memorable excursion to the Pyramids of Giza and the Great Sphinx. Marvel at the awe-inspiring pyramids, last remaining wonder of the ancient world, and uncover the stories behind these remarkable feats of ancient engineering. Nearby, the Great Sphinx stands as a powerful symbol of mystery and mythology, guarding the plateau for over 4000 years. The afternoon is at leisure, allowing you time to relax or explore. (B)

Sunday 24th January 2027

Enjoy a full day at the newly opened Grand Egyptian Museum. Home to the world's largest collection of Egyptian artefacts, the museum features incredible treasures from the tomb of King Tutankhamun, along with countless other relics that reveal the artistry, culture and daily life of ancient Egypt. Wander the impressive galleries and immerse yourself in a journey across thousands of years of history. (B)

Monday 25th January 2027

This morning, have another opportunity to visit the Grand Egyptian Museum before transferring to the airport for our flight to Luxor this evening. Our home for the next 7 nights is the Jolie Ville Kings Island Resort. (B)

Tuesday 26th January 2027

Today, we journey to West Bank A, the sacred burial ground of Egypt's New Kingdom pharaohs. We visit the two Colossi of Memnon, two towering statues of Pharaoh Amenophis III, built 3,400 years ago. We explore the striking temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir El-Bahari. Venture to the Valley of the Kings, the final resting place of over 60 royal tombs, including that of Seti I, where you can admire the intricate wall paintings and marvel at the grandeur of ancient Egyptian burial traditions. 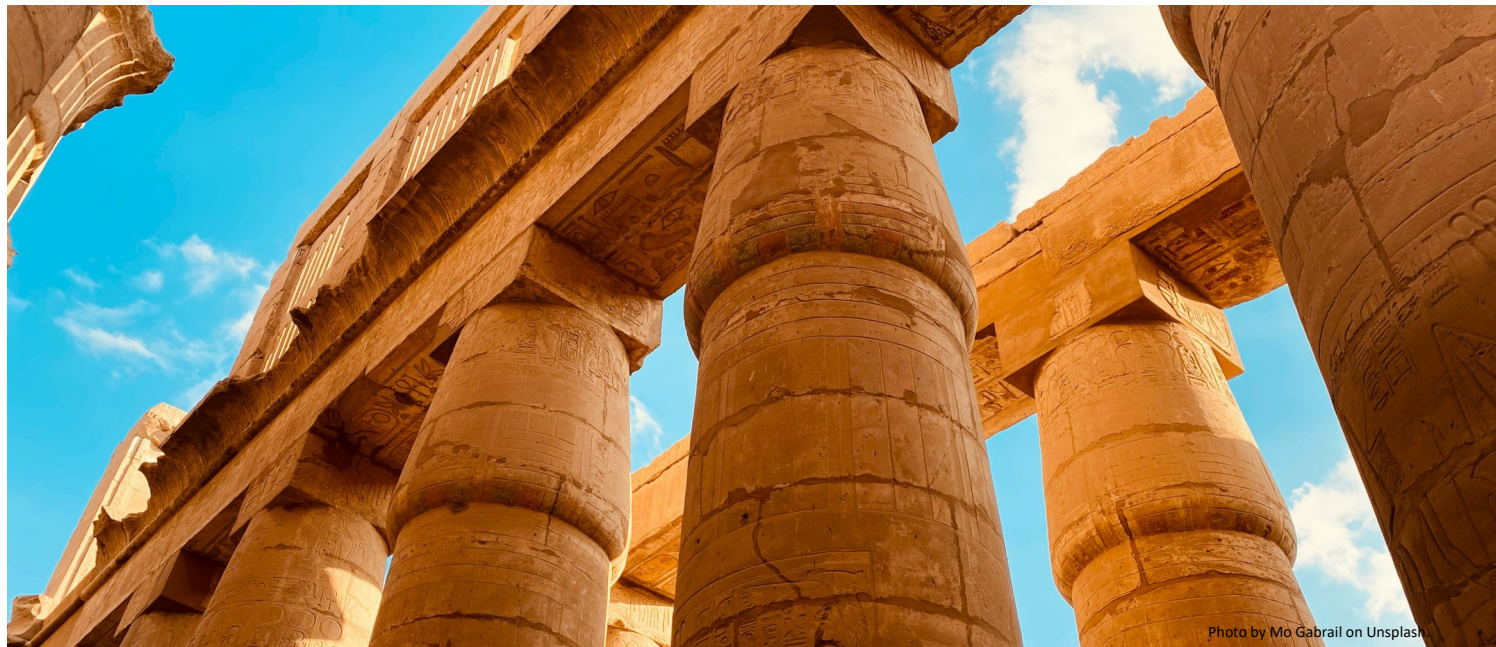

Itinerary Continued...

Wednesday 27th January 2027

Take a day to unwind and recharge at your own pace. Relax by the pool, indulge in a soothing spa treatment, or set out to explore the area independently. (B,D)

Thursday 28th January 2027

Embark on a full day tour to Dendera and Abydos, two remarkable sites of ancient Egypt. At Dendera, explore one of the best-preserved temple complexes in the country, originally known as Tentyris. The site was home to three sanctuaries; Horus, Ihy, and Hathor, with the Sanctuary of Hathor surviving almost intact. Abydos, one of the oldest cities of ancient Egypt, long revered as a sacred site, where history and tradition echo through its ancient monuments and burial grounds. (B,D)

Friday 29th January 2027

Discover the iconic temples of Karnak and Luxor. Karnak or *Ipet-sut*, was a major religious centre and home to the Great Temple of Amun. Luxor Temple, largely built by Amenhotep III and Ramses II, played a key role in the annual Opet Festival, when the statues of Amun, Mut and Khonsu were carried along the Avenue of the Sphinxes. These temples offer a remarkable glimpse into the grandeur and spiritual life of ancient Egypt. (B,D)

Saturday 30th January 2027

Today, we explore more of the West Bank's most fascinating sites. Visit the Valley of the Queens, the burial site of the New Kingdom royal wives and princess; Medinat Habu, Ramses III's impressive temple and a centre of Thebes' religious and economic life. Deir El-Medina, the ancient village of artisans who built and decorated the royal tombs, offering a rare glimpse into the daily lives of those who served the pharaohs. (B,D)

Sunday 31st January 2027

Enjoy a relaxing day at leisure, taking advantage of your hotel's pool or venture out to explore the surroundings at your own pace. (B,D)

Monday 1st February 2027

Enjoy breakfast before heading to the airport for our flight to London Heathrow with memories of a fabulous tour. (B)
