Tour Itinerary

Thursday 3rd December 2026

We depart early morning and start our journey to London. We make a lunch stop en route before continuing our journey to the Grims Dyke Hotel in Harrow, our hotel for the next 3 nights. (D)

Friday 4th December 2026

This morning, after a hearty cooked breakfast, we travel in to central London to Convent Garden. Every year Covent Garden transforms into one of London's most magical festive destinations with lots of twinkly lights and a huge Christmas tree. Perhaps do some Christmas shopping at the festive pop-up shops and artisan traders or sample some festive drinks in one of the many bars. Mid afternoon we will transfer the group to Royal Botanical Gardens Kew, to enjoy the spectacular light trail known as 'Christmas at Kew'. We depart mid evening and travel back to our hotel where we enjoy a late supper. (B,D)

Saturday 5th December 2026

After a leisurely breakfast, we depart and travel back in to central London. We set down near to the Knightsbridge area, where you have time to explore one of the many museums. Perhaps visit the V&A Museum, which typically hosts seasonal trails and festive displays. Alternatively, you could take a visit to famous department store Harrods, which transforms part of its lower ground floor into 'Christmas World'. You'll find a wonderland of garlands, baubles, wreaths, and unique ornaments, plus limited-edition collectible Christmas bears and seasonal gifts. We drive back to the hotel with time to relax before dinner. (B,D)

Sunday 6th December 2026

We depart our hotel this morning and start our journey to the beautiful NT Upton House and gardens, which is a stunning 17th-century country house. The rooms inside the house are festively decorated at Christmas with enchanting displays creating a magical atmosphere. Here you have time to explore and get some lunch (at own expense) before we continue our drive back to Staffordshire. (B)

4* Grim's Dyke Hotel, Harrow
